The Artificial Insemination Course provides participants with the necessary skills to conduct an AI program on their own livestock. Participants will be able to apply their knowledge and skills to prepare for insemination, time insemination to coincide with oestrus cycles, prepare equipment and work sites, correctly select and thaw semen for insemination, inseminate animals, clean up and record data after insemination is complete. Unit will be delivered under AHC32810 Cert III in Rural Operations.

**What to bring:** Suitable outdoor work wear; Accommodation - linen, pillow (or swag); towel; water bottle.
