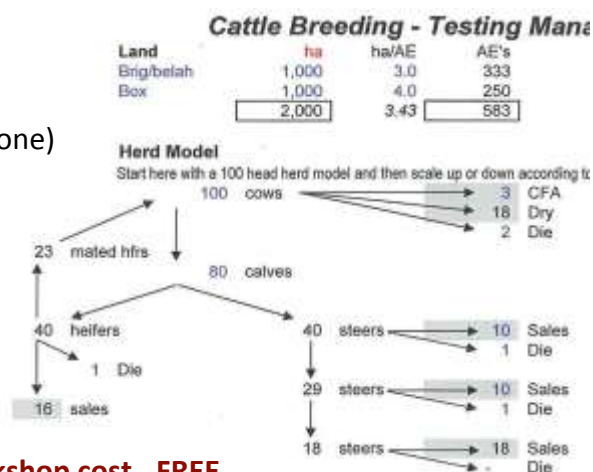
This one day workshop covers questions like:

We will use a simple excel spreadsheet (which you can take home) that helps methodically assess the profitability of an enterprise and management changes. This workshop helps determine “what are the economics of...” a range of components of your grazing enterprise.
