Background:

In 2016, Queensland reduced Johne's disease regulation in favor of an industry led market driven approach. In February 2017, the Northern Territory legislated minimum entry requirements of Johne's Beef Assurance Score (JBAS) of 7 for all cattle moving in to the NT.

Until 30 June, all Johne's disease-free properties in QLD are JBAS 7. However, from 1 July 2017, all QLD properties that fail to implement a biosecurity plan will fall to the lowest level of assurance JBAS 0.
