


# FORAGE BUDGETING

## TRAINING WORKSHOP

Adjusting stocking rates to match current feed supply to animal requirements, is one of the key drivers in business sustainability. Retaining adequate levels of pasture cover at the end of the dry season maximises pasture growth and carrying capacity for the following summer.



How to estimate your pasture yield quickly and accurately for your own paddocks.



Effectively calculate the season's stocking and forage demands to crunch and monitor numbers to suit the available feed supply.



Understanding land types and land condition as an initial benchmark for stocking rates.

*Forage budgeting maximises animal production, reduces dry season supplementary feeding costs and improves the condition of grazing land.*
