



- Our support is independent, confidential, impartial and free




Practice change first requires an analysis of the present. A Farm Business Resilience Plan will provide your business with a blueprint for future success.




Business planning is a process not an event.

- A good Resilience Plan involves a team effort with assistance from many experts

 QDAF Extension Team, NRM Groups, RFC, Accountants, Solicitors and many more. Referrals to these specialists is key for this program.
- Goal setting should be driven by achievable outcomes
- We will help identify risks and options available so that producers can develop strategies to get to where they want to go.

- Access government support including QRIDA Drought Preparedness and Support Packages

Where do I Start?


- If you already have a relationship with an RFC this is the easiest place to start. You can also refer to the contact map to contact your local RFC direct or our Head Office
- 2. Speak with your local Beef Extension Officer from QDAF
- 3. Talk with your local NRM Group

Counsellors *assist* producers with their plans. An RFC will work with you though your plan – not just "fill out paperwork"

We provide options *not* advice. We take a person centered approach with the understanding that you know what is best for you. We will not tell you what to do.

Referrals are given for specific advice (and *may* eligible for the Farm Management Grants (\$2500)).

Timelines for a first appointment can vary and the Plan completion timeline varies.
