



# Pigeonpea & Alternative Summer Crops Field Walk

- (1) A display of advanced pigeonpea lines and a discussion on DPI's target to build a new pigeonpea industry in Queensland.
- (2) A display of alternative summer crops and cover options, including the results of a crimping demonstration.

The pigeonpea trial is funded by the Queensland Government and the Grains Research and Development Corporation. The alternative crops trial is funded by the Australian Government's Future Drought Fund, and the Queensland Government's Drought and Climate Adaptation Program as part of the Farm Business Resilience Program.
