Stocktake Plus how to:

Create an accessible yield sheet

Accessible yield sheets allow you to break down paddocks into discrete management units to better estimate yield. This can allow you to take into account distance from water, preferential grazing and inaccessible areas such as steep hills or river beds.

To create an accessible yield sheet

- 1. Select 'accessible yield sheets'.
- 2. Select 'add new yield sheet'.
- 3. Select a paddock, which will automatically select the total area available.
- 4. Select 'add management unit'.
- 5. Type in a name for the management unit e.g. Hill, Spinifex.
- Enter an area for the management unit e.g. a rocky hill takes up 10 hectares of the paddock.
- Type in the amount of pasture available in the management area, e.g. there may be a lot of pasture as the area is not grazed or it may not grow much pasture due to soil.
- 8. The App will calculate the proportion of the total area and the contribution to the yield, e.g. there may be 5000kg DM/ha but it only makes up 1% of the paddock so only contribute 50kg DM/ha to the total useful pasture.
- Click 'save' to exit and enter another management unit until the total area is accounted for and an average accessible yield is calculated.
- 10. Clicks 'save' to exit.
